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#### ARTICLE 5

Tryon Life Community Farm is organized and shall be operated exclusively for charitable, educational and scientific purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

Tryon Life Community Farm shall have as its primary purposes: outreach and education about sustainable living & agriculture; restoring native ecosystems; integrating arts and the environment; and promoting community development.

No part of the net earnings of the organization shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth.

No substantial part of the activities of Tryon Life Community farm shall be attempting to influence legislation, and the organization shall not participate in any political campaign on behalf of a candidate running for office.

The Board of Directors shall create such committees that are necessary to make the regular management decisions regarding the Tryon Life Community Farm. Such committees will be comprised of individuals who are not necessarily on the Board of Directors.

No director or uncompensated coordinator of the corporation shall be personally liable to the corporation for monetary damages for conduct as a director or coordinator, so long as the director or coordinator acts in compliance with the standards set out in ORS 65, and in furtherance of the established goals of the corporation.

#### ARTICLE 8

Upon dissolution or final liquidation of this organization, and after the payment or provision for payment of all the outstanding liabilities, the remaining assets of the corporation shall be distributed to other organizations that share a common purpose as Tryon Life Community Farm, and are described in current section 501(c)(3) of the tax code, or corresponding sections of a future tax code, as the board of directors may determine.
